


FirstNet In-Action.... Delivering on Our Singular Focus

The First Responder Network Authority shall hold the single public safety wireless license and take all actions necessary to ensure the building, deployment, and operation of the nationwide public safety broadband network

Deployables



- 72 FirstNet-dedicated SatCOLT deployables now available
- "Lending library" approach: Subscribing agencies can request at no cost to support scenarios, from disasters, to critical incidents and planned events
- Service included all expenses directly associated with FirstNet deployables are included, at no cost to public safety



FirstNet in action: 2018 Boston Marathon


