



- Law: Privacy
- Law: Public Disclosure ("FOIA")
- Law: HIPPA, ADA
- Policy (National): CJIS

- Standards and Guidelines to better enable sharing
 Ex: APCO and P25, Google GTFS
- Delete Unneeded Data
 Ex: Seattle PD AVL data
 since 2009






- Public Pressure to share data or restrict sharing or to change law/policy
 Ex: Seattle and Video Cameras
- Attorney General or City Attorney Opinion:
 Ex: Use of body-worn video in private homes
- Change the Policy/Law Ex: Seattle Police
 911 Calls





- View, don't Download
 Ex: CJIS Data
- Robust redaction systems or filters
 - Ex: Remove PII and SSN's automatically





- Good interagency governance
 Ex: Public Safety Radio Networks
- Talk and communicate to improve sharing Ex: Tribal Nations and MOUs
 - Ex: Seattle Police & Fire Crisis Intervention





 Money talks: Fund it! (And they will come) Ex: NCIS funded LInX/D-DEx Regional Map LInX (Law Enforcement Information Exchange)
