Answer: if only one thing could change, what would have the most impact?


Approach

- > Solve the biggest issue we can solve



- Instant information sharing


Crime Data Warehouse – 911 calls mapped instantly




Crime Data Warehouse – Create Incident Report





Search for Suspect Wearing Green Bay Packers t-shirt




4 incidents found in past five years where suspect wore Green Bay Packers clothing
